The address is 12 Plumdon Park Avenue, Annan DG12 6EY

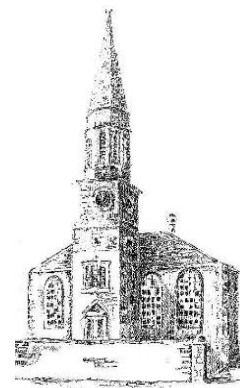
APPEALS
