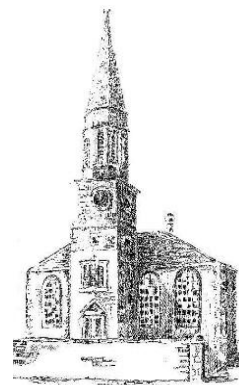
The Singing Group will start up again on Monday 24th August, in Annan Old Hall, at 7.00 p.m.
